# Phlebotomy 75 hours



## Overview:

This program will prepare graduates to work as an entry-level **Phlebotomy Technician** in a clinic, hospital, nursing home or long-term care facility. Graduates will be able to assist in basic laboratory procedures, collecting blood (phlebotomy) and other clinical tasks.

This course is designed to meet the National Health Career Association (NHA) and New York State Education Department curriculum requirements. The course will prepare graduates for **National NHA Professional Certification – Certified Phlebotomy Technician (CPT).** The course includes both theory and clinical training.

The course curriculum is approved by the New York State Education Department, by NCCT, and by National Health Career Association (NHA).

### Who Should Attend?

This course is designed for those (men and women) looking for employment as Phlebotomy Technician, and is recommended for all students considering nursing careers. Combination with the **EKG program and with CNA program** will allow graduates to work as an entry-level **Patient Care Technician** in a clinic, hospital, nursing home or long-term care facility.

This course is offered as continuing education or professional development course to participants in order to enhance existing employment in the medical field.
