

Higher Education Emergency Relief Funds Grant (HEERF)

New Age Training is pleased that Congress is providing support for higher education in the face of COVID-19, including its establishment of the \$14 billion Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund. These funds are being allocated largely based on enrollment of students who qualify for Title IV funding under section 484 of the Higher Education Act.

New Age Training received the HEERF grant for our students on April 30th, 2020. We will start submitting grant applications to all eligible active students who are enrolled or will be enrolled by June 30th, 2020. Applications will be reviewed in the order in which they are received. Completing this form does not guarantee funding availability, or that all needs will be met.

In response to the global Covid-19 Pandemic, the U.S. Government has enacted the CARES Act to provide, among other things, financial support for students for expenses related to the disruption of campus operations due to coronavirus (including eligible expenses under a student's cost of attendance such as food, housing, course materials, technology, health care, and child care) through the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF).

All students eligible for financial aid and who meet the criteria will be eligible for the HEERF grant and will receive an application via email.

We have allocated funds for all students who are eligible for financial aid based on their enrollment status. At this time, the maximum one-time amount of emergency assistance that will be provided by this grant is \$700.

Funds have been reserved for **all eligible students who met financial aid and school requirements:**

- Students who are currently attending school for at least 30 days (they will start receiving grant application this week)
- Students who are currently attending school and started a program less than 30 days ago (they will start receiving grant application after they meet 30 days enrollment period)
- Students who are currently on approved Leave of Absence (they will start receiving grant application after they return from LOA)
- Future students who are scheduled to start by June 30th, 2020

Students must attest to the need for the grant for the purposes required by the law on the application form and sign as indicated. Please note that these grants may be subject to federal and state income tax. New Age Training will issue HEERF grants to students by paper check which will be mailed to the student according to the mailing address specified on the Grant Application.

Students must meet special criteria listed on the next page in order to be eligible to receive a grant. Grant is allocated to all eligible students even for those who are currently not meeting eligibility requirements. Students who are temporary not meeting attendance/academic or other requirements and whose grant application was initially denied will be able to re-apply for a grant if they fix a problem before July 31st, 2020 or return from LOA before July 31st, 2020.
